## **PRODUCT RECALL: WOODY'S ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PRODUCTS**

The MLCC has voluntarily recalled all Woody's alcoholic beverage products sold in Manitoba and is suspending the sale of these products until further notice. This follows last week's warning from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) advising that Woody's Mexican lime vodka cooler may contain harmful glass fragments. The MLCC issued a recall for that product on November 10, 2011.

The additional Woody's products being recalled are:

- Woody's Blackcurrant Apple 330ml
- Woody's Blueberry 330ml
- Woody's Pink Grapefruit 330ml
- Woody's Sasparilla 330ml
- Pomtini Vodka & Pomegranite 330ml

This recall was prompted after the MLCC's Quality Control department found glass contamination in the Woody's line of alcoholic beverage products. There has been one reported injury associated with the consumption of Woody's Mexican Lime Vodka Cooler.

Customers who have previously purchased these products may return them to their local Liquor Mart or liquor vendor for a full refund.
